## **ORDER OF DRAW BADGE BUDDY**

- When using a butterfly for venipuncture, a discard tube (blue top or a tube with no additive) should be drawn before the sodium citrate tube (blue top)
  The discard tube does not need to be completely filled, only enough space to fill the collection set's "dead space"
- Completely fill the Sodium Citrate tube to be used for testing to blue fill line.
- 2 sets of initials are required on all blood bank specimens when a secondary blood bank banding system is not in use.

- Remove tourniquet before drawing lactic acid





One Inversion
