## Huddle Topic Blood Culture Draw Technique

**Purpose: Reduce Blood Culture Contamination** 

**Prevent Blood Culture Contamination** by following these steps for every blood culture draw:

- 1. Perform hand hygiene and don clean gloves
- 2. Pop the caps of **1** aerobic and **1** anaerobic bottle
- 3. Scrub bottles' septums for 30 seconds with CHG. Do not place in the bed.
- 4. Wrap tourniquet
- 5. Find your vein- DO NOT DRAW FROM ANY LINE. Line draws can lead to:
  - Contamination due to culturing biofilm on the line

  - Inappropriate treatment
- 6. Scrub skin with Chloraprep/CHG for 30 seconds, then air dry for 30 seconds
  - if drawing from a moist area scrub for 2 minutes and dry for 1 minute
- 7. DO NOT TOUCH THE AREA YOU SCRUBBED
- 8. Use the blood transfer device to inject blood into bottles
- 9. Fill bottles alphabetically: **Blue/Grey** (aerobic) THEN **Purple/Pink** (anaerobic)
- 10. Date/Time/Initial/Source
- 11. Place both bottles in 1 biohazard bag
